

Scholarship Programs

In conjunction with the Swiss Benevolent Society of Philadelphia, the Swiss Benevolent Society of New York offers the following scholarship programs for Swiss-American students residing in New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Delaware and Pennsylvania:

SBS Merit Scholarship

The SBS Merit Scholarship, formerly known as "Pellegrini Scholarship - merit only", is a partial tuition grant, which is based on merit alone (cumulative Grade Point Average at least 3.0). It is awarded at the post-secondary school level for vocational or undergraduate and graduate academic studies at a college or university accredited by the U.S. Department of Education. SBS Outstanding Scholastic Achievement (OSA) Award

This award may be granted to a college senior or graduate student who demonstrates sustained academic excellence (cumulative Grade Point Average at least 3.8) in a demanding study program. The college or university mustbe accredited by the U.S. Department of Education. To check whether your school is accredited please go the following website: <u>https://ope.ed.gov/dapip/</u>

SBS Graduate Award

SBS Graduate Awards will be granted to the graduate students with the highest cumulative Grade Point Average. The SBS Graduate Award is a one-time only award. The college or university must be accredited by the U.S. Department of Education. To check whether your school is accredited please go the following website: <u>https://ope.ed.gov/dapip/</u>

Medicus Student Exchange Scholarship

This program provides partial financial support for U.S. residents at the junior, senior or graduate college level who have been accepted to study at a Swiss University or Federal Institute of Technology. Eligibility

Applicants or one of his or her parents must be Swiss national, permanently domiciled in New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Pennsylvania or Delaware and of good academic standing. Please carefully review the scholarship-specific eligibility requirements for the above mentioned scholarships at https://www.sbsny.org/scholarships/eligibility-application.

Application deadlines and required supporting documents

E-mail your application form together with the following documents to the Scholarship Committee by **March 31st 2024**: - Proof of Swiss citizenship of applicant or one parent (Copy of Swiss passport or copy of Consulate recognition letter)

- Proof of applicant's U.S. citizenship or U.S. residency
- Proof of cost for tuition and room and board (e.g. copy of bursar's bill, screenshot of university website)
- If available, we recommend that you submit SAT/ACT or GRE/GMAT results

Please also provide the following documents by April 30th 2024:

- For Freshmen only: Official high school transcripts
- For all others: Official college transcripts (no copies)

- One (for SBS Merit Scholarships) or two (for SBS OSA or SBS Graduate Awards) current letters of reference from high school principal, guidance counselor, or professor in the in the applicant's major area of study on official letterhead (no copies)

Applications or supporting documents submitted after March 31st resp. April 30th will not be considered. The SBS does not confirm receipt of applications to students.

Application fee
